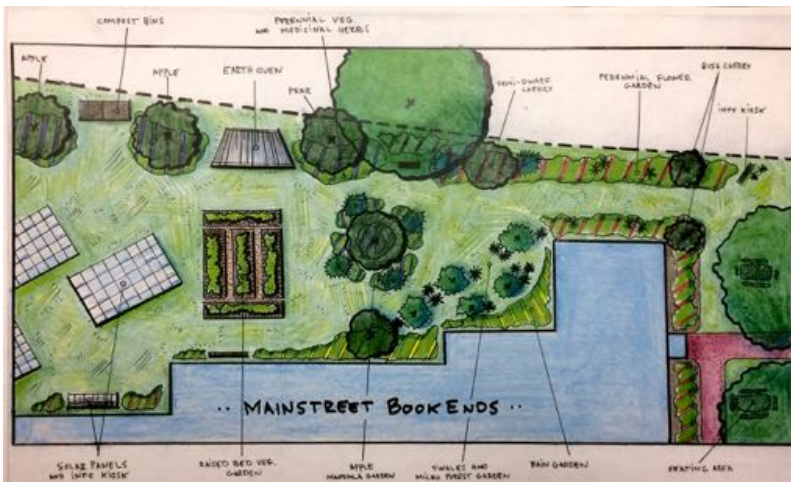

- A Main Street entrance into an edible and educational landscape in and around the solar panels, to include sculptures and other forms of art
- A working garden space for vegetables, nuts, fruits, berries, herbs, and compost

- Constructing an outdoor earthen oven for community bakes, and establishing a defined area for an outdoor classroom

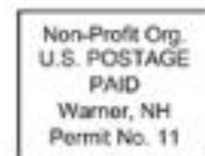
