And we reopened the last phase for the Jim Mitchell Community Park, the Children's Park.

2020 marks the 20th anniversary of MainStreet Warner, Inc.'s service to Warner and a time for remarkable growth and reflection.

2000 - The non-profit is founded by Jim Mitchell, his sister Katharine and her husband Neil Nevins. Start offering "Friday Nights on Main Street" entertainment, music and educational programming, operating out of The Gallery at MainStreet BookEnds.

2005 - Start of the annual Literacy Day at Simonds Elementary School, bringing authors and their books to each student.

2006 - The land is turned over to the non-profit for creation of the community park.

2007 - Park design created by Pellettieri Associates, Inc. - Jim begins actively promoting a community park... free to all.

2008 - The sudden death of Jim Mitchell brings a community outpouring to continue with his vision for the town.

2010 - Through grants, monetary and in-kind donations, and volunteers the Jim Mitchell Community Park opens with the granite terrace on October 10th.

2016 - The MainStreet Warner Stage and Amphitheater opens to the public during the Warner Fall Foliage Festival, providing outdoor free entertainment.

2020 - Through remarkable donations and individual loans, MainStreet Warner Inc. purchases the former Harris Masonic Lodge on September 25th. The Children's Park opens on October 10th.

2021 ~ Work continues to restore The Lodge.
~ Further growth of the Children's Park to provide an edible landscape for exploration and play.
~ Continued community outreach and partnerships, including Simonds Elementary School.

This has been the most difficult of years, but Warner's community spirit and resilience will bring us out again, to be able to gather, and to provide solace and strength to each other.
